DIRECTIONS

From the North: Garden State Parkway South, to Exit 149. Turn left onto John F. Kennedy Memorial Drive. Proceed two blocks to traffic light. Turn right onto Liberty Street and proceed one block to the campus.

From the South: Garden State Parkway North, to Exit 148. Continue north on John F. Kennedy Memorial Drive to 4th traffic light. Turn left onto Liberty Street and proceed two blocks to the campus.

From the West: Route 78 East or Route 280 East to Garden State Parkway North, to Exit 148. Continue north on John F. Kennedy Memorial Drive to 4th traffic light. Turn left onto Liberty Street and proceed two blocks to the campus.

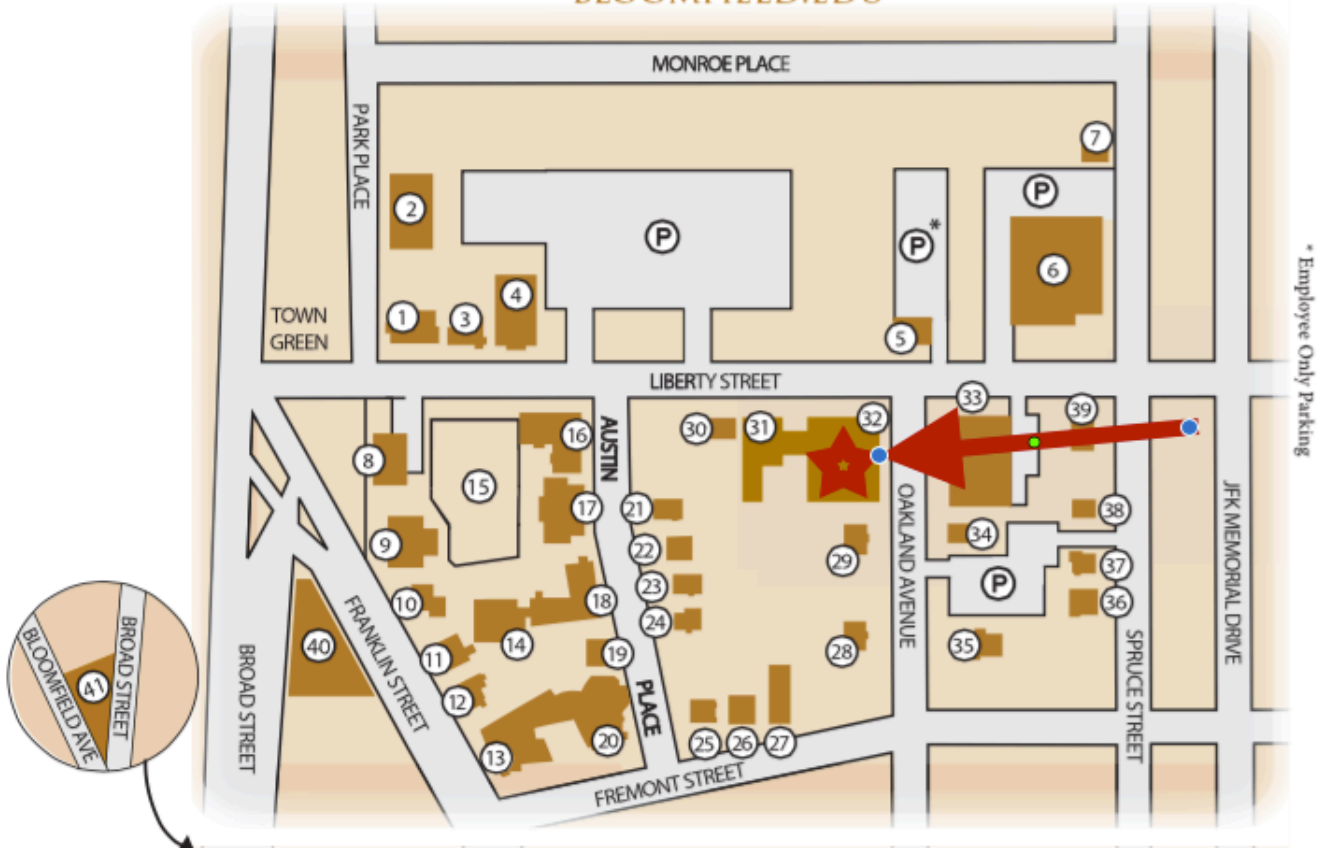
From New York City and Points East: George Washington Bridge to Route 80 West or Lincoln Tunnel to Route 3 West, to Garden State Parkway South, to Exit 149. Turn left onto John F. Kennedy Memorial Drive. Proceed two blocks to traffic light. Turn right onto Liberty Street and proceed one block to the campus.

Free Parking is available in the main campus lot located at 225 Liberty Street, Bloomfield, NJ 07003. Metered street parking is also available.
